**COMMUNITY**

West Springfield High School serves over 2,200 highly motivated students, 90% of whom plan to continue their education beyond high school. The school benefits from the interest and support of an involved parent community. Since Springfield, Virginia, is a suburb of Washington, D.C., many WSHS parents are professionals associated with the federal government or the military.

**SPECIAL CURRICULUM FEATURES**

In response to the educational interests of the community, West Springfield offers a variety of challenging and specialized academic programs beyond the standard Fairfax County Public Schools' curriculum offerings.

Students with special needs receive instruction through specialized programs which include learning disabilities resource, team taught, and self-contained classes. Students with limited English skills and whose second language is English are enrolled in the English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Program.

**HONORS CURRICULUM:** Students may enroll in an enriched Honors Curriculum. Honors classes are labeled (HN) on the transcript, except for six courses. They are French 5, German 5, Spanish 5, STEM Engineering, STEM Advanced Engineering and Emerging Technology and STEM Advanced Electronics & Robotics. **Honors courses are weighted with an additional 0.5 quality point.**

**ADVANCED PLACEMENT:** Advanced Placement courses are indicated by the designation (AP) preceding the course title on the transcript. **AP courses are weighted with an additional 1.0 quality point.** WSHS offers the following twenty-seven advanced placement courses: AP Biology, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, AP Capstone Seminar, AP Chemistry, AP Comparative Government & Politics, AP Computer Science A, AP Government, AP English Language, AP English Literature, AP Environmental Science, AP French Language, AP German Language, AP Human Geography, AP Latin-Vergil, AP Macro/Microeconomics, AP Music Theory, AP Physics 1, AP Physics 2, AP Physics C M&EM, AP Psychology, AP Spanish Language, AP Statistics, AP Studio Art (2D Design Portfolio), AP Studio Art (Drawing Portfolio), AP U.S. History, AP World History.

**Dual Enrollment Courses:** Dual Enrollment classes, designated with a (DE) after their title are semester-long classes approved for high school credit as well as college credit through the Northern Virginia Community College system. **DE courses are weighted with an additional 0.5 quality point.**
