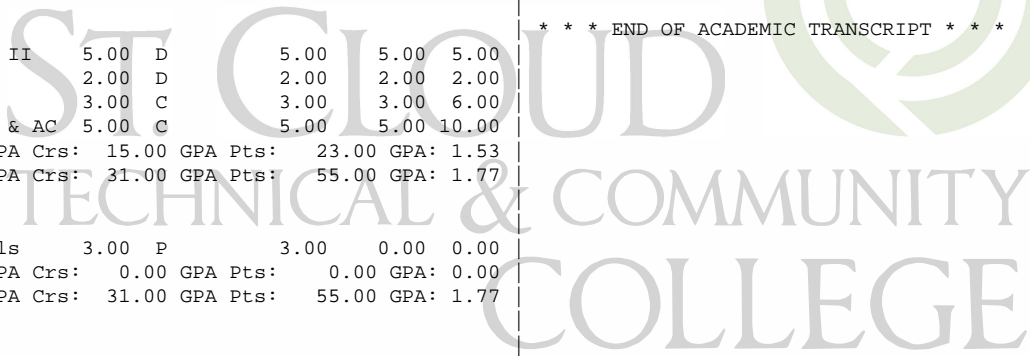

**ACCREDITATION**

St. Cloud Technical & Community College is regionally accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (June, 1985). Many specialized programs also have professional accreditation. All programs are approved by the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities System and the state approving agency of Veterans Education.

**ACADEMIC CALENDAR**

St. Cloud Technical & Community College converted from the quarter calendar to the semester calendar in August 1998. Academic terms prior to Fall 1998 have not been converted to semester hours, except in summary totals, which follow the last quarter term. Beginning Fall 1998, all credits are in semester hours.

**ACADEMIC HONORS**

Students qualify for Dean's List honors by completing 6 or more credits in a semester with a 3.50 – 3.99 GPA. Students qualify for President's List honors by completing 6 or more credits in a semester with a 4.0 GPA. Students must be admitted into a major and have no incomplete grades or disciplinary actions on file. Academic honors for graduation are earned with a cumulative GPA of 3.50 or higher.

**ACADEMIC WARNING/SUSPENSION**

When a student's cumulative grade-point average is below a 2.0 or their cumulative completion rate is below 66.66%, the student is placed on academic warning. A student who has been placed on warning and fails to maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA the following term, or does not meet the 66.66% completion rate of all attempted credits, will be suspended from the college for a period of one regular semester (excluding summer).

**INCOMPLETES**

All grades of "I" or "IP" must be completed within the term immediately following that term in which the Incomplete was earned (excluding summer). Grades for courses not completed within that time frame convert to an "F" if the instructor has not submitted a grade.

**REPEATED COURSES**

A student who receives a grade of "B," "C," "D," or "F" may repeat these courses in an effort to improve their grades. The highest grade earned will be the student's official grade for the course. No courses or grades will be removed from the transcript. A grade of "FW" earned prior to summer 2016 may also be repeated.

**TRANSFER CREDIT**

Credits accepted from another institution of higher learning or by petition are recorded in quarter or semester hours in the top left on the transcript. Grades of transfer courses are not computed in the cumulative GPA.

**HOURLY-BASED COURSES**

Hour-based courses may also appear on this transcript. These courses are a customized training service offered by the St. Cloud Technical & Community College. Students normally do not receive grades for hour-based courses, but do receive a certificate of attendance. These courses are not included in a student's GPA.
