I know Colter from watching him play baseball as he's grown up, as well as being his teacher in Math last year. As a student, he stood out to me because he worked to understand the concepts I was teaching. Often, kids are motivated only by a good grade, but I felt like Colter understood that if he worked to get the concepts, then the grade would come as a result. I was impressed with his willingness to try things that didn't come real easy to him, something I think is a very coachable trait.
